Materials

- 2. Each family must have a home subscription to SmartMusic.

Instruments

Each student is responsible for supplying his /her own instrument. Instruments must be kept in proper playing condition. All personal equipment must be labeled. All instrument cases must be clearly labeled with your child's name and grade. Instruments must be brought home at the end of the school day. Instruments are not to be left in the school over night. They are not insured after school hours.

- 1. **Brass** must keep their valves well oiled and have extra valve oil on hand.
- 2. **Woodwind** must have extra reeds, cork grease and cleaning cloths in their case at all times.
- 3. **Percussionists** must own <u>all equipment</u> listed below before being registered for band **Required Percussion equipment list: Percussion kit includes a 2 -1/2 octave Bells(notes G3 C5), Acrylic, Yarn, and Timpani Mallets ,5A and 2B drumsticks, a Remo practice pad, a Stick bag and a drum key.

Lessons

Students are excused from their regular classes to attend instrumental lessons on a rotating schedule. Lessons are part of the school curriculum and attendance is required. Students will be given materials for weekly practice that must be kept in their band binder. Students will also be required to purchase repertoire books as needed. Coming to lessons without required materials or unpracticed lessons will affect their lesson grade.

Instrumental Lesson Procedure

Instrumental students must follow the same procedure before attending a lesson

- 1. Before a student goes to their lesson, the student is to inform the teacher of their lesson, and hand in any homework due for that day.
- 2. After the lesson, the student; must check with their classmates or teacher about class activities or additional assignments.
- 3. If a student has a test or a quiz that period, they are to stay in class. Then report to Mr. Chetcuti to schedule a make up lesson.
- 4. Make up lessons must be completed within one week to receive credit.

Website support and technology

The Edline page for band will provide you with the basic information that you and your child will need to know about band. Here you will find rehearsal schedules, a calendar of events, FAQs, band forms to download, interactive music benchmarks and other important information.

SmartMusic (<u>www.smartmusic.com</u>)

Students are required purchase the interactive music software called SmartMusic. This program will contain music for lessons, concerts and supplementary materials. Smart music will also chart how long a student is practicing each week. Student will also be asked to keep a notebook of scales, rhythm, etudes, and other material.

Rehearsals

All band rehearsals will be held in the Band Room (04) on the bottom level.

Morning rehearsals begin at 7:40 am and end at 8:20.

Attendance is mandatory. Missed rehearsals/performances will affect your child's grade.

6th Grade Band will meet Tuesdays and Thursdays

7th & 8th Grade Band will meet on Mondays and Wednesdays

Concerts

There are two required performances.

Semester 1 - Winter Concert (January 6, 2011 – 7:30 @ SMS auditorium)

Semester 2 - Spring Concert (June 2, 2011 - 7:30 @ SMS auditorium)

Jazz club will only perform at the Spring Concert.

Fife & Drum will perform at the Somers Veteran's day and Memorial Day Parades.

Concert Attire

Band members are required to wear concert dress attire at all functions. (Same for Jazz Club)

*Boys - White button down oxford shirt, dark slacks, socks, shoes and a dark long tie.

*Girls - White button down blouse, ANKLE length black skirt and black shoes

Transportation
